1. Opening of the GA

The third General Assembly of the academic year 2025-2026 is held in the EUC Atrium and starts at 18.15. Boyan (the EUCSA chair) welcomes everyone.

- Boyan asks everyone to sit down and explains that General Assemblies are there to discuss and vote on issues and topics that concern EUCSA.
- He goes on to mention that this is a regular GA, to go over the plan for the rest of the year, but also the Reallocation GA, in which we will mutate the current Budget plan for this financial year of EUCSA (lasting until Quad 1 of academic year 2026/27)
- The agenda is proposed and a question follows
 - *Gijs asks why there is no snacktime (break) in the GA agenda*
 - *Boyan answers that we will reconsider it for the next GA as that is also a longer GA.*
- The agenda is passed by acclamation as there are no amendments proposed.
- Further, Boyan asks everyone to raise their hands and mention their name when they want to say something.

2. Updates

Boyan continues with the updates regarding Quad 3 which have happened since the Winter Break.

- Incoming Exchange Introduction Day
 - EUCSA organises this every year and we had a reasonable turnout. We did a little tour of Rotterdam, went bowling and ended off with pizzas from the Rotterdam staple Little Italy.
- Social Drinks Quad 3
 - The Social Drinks were a big success, with an incredible turnout after Winter break and the exchange students coming back. We are glad to have this tight of a community.
- Ski Team x Party Co Party
 - We sold more than 220 tickets and it was a great party with a lot of dancing!
- Committee Thank You Event
 - Yesterday we had a Thank You Event for all committees by organizing a beerpong tournament. Sport Co won, but in the end we are all winners!

4. Plans for the Rest of the Year

Boyan continues to talk about the plans for the rest of the year:

- Weekly Banners
 - We have arranged the weekly banners to be on the screens and will keep them updated.
- Debate Co x Cedo Nulli MUN simulation
 - We extended the partnership with Cedo Nulli to collaborate in a NMUN simulation. We are super excited to have professional trainers come by. Tickets are on the website!
- Palestine Awareness Week
 - Will be hosted in Quad 3 to raise awareness whilst hosting events.
- Ski Trip
 - Will be happening in the Spring Break, there are still five tickets left!
 - *Sanne and Gaja hyped it up even more at the GA.*
- Election Period
 - We will kick off the election period soon, more information will follow on the email and the Instagram

Boyan Welcomes Nina and Sophia (both Committee Affairs Officer of the EUCSA Board) to the stage to finish up the updates.

- 5 Board Credits
 - The exciting news is shared that Board members of both EUCSA and SAAC will be receiving 5 credits for their respective work. The assignment is being finalized, but it is official!
- The Mascot
 - The Mascot is officially bought and displayed on the screen, as it has not arrived yet. There will be updates about the Mascot coming up! 'He looks quite dapper!' (excuse me for the possibility of this being spelled as incorrectly as imaginable)

5. Membership Restructure Idea

Nina and Sophia welcome Boyan back on stage, who continues the GA by speaking about the idea to restructure the Memberships.

- The idea is to give members that are buying the membership for multiple years in a row, to provide a discount, so we retain more members and grow as an association.
 - We do not know if the amount of money we get out of this will stay the same, become higher, or lower than without this system. But its goal is to have more members.

The floor is open for questions about this idea after Ivar (EUCSA Secretary Vice-Chair) reminds the members that there will not be any official voting today on the matter and that this is merely a proposal. The people were positive and did not ask questions. The Board will go and work on it, so we can vote on it at GA 4.

6. Budget Reallocation

Boyan welcomes Anna to the stage to lead the Budget Reallocation.

- Anna explains that the Budget Reallocation serves the purpose to have a half-year checkup on the financial health of the association and reallocate according to needs and performance of Committees.
- The explanation of the Reallocation's content, as communicated via email is done
 - It is explained that no Committee will get less money allocated, which is not always the case, but we are doing well this financial year.
 - It is also explained which Committees get more money and why.

Anna opens the floor for any questions regarding the Reallocation. But there are no questions. So Anna closes the floor and the GA proceeds to official voting. Followed by a short break to count the votes.

- Budget Proposal:
 - Total Votes: 36
 - In favour: 33
 - Against: 0
 - Blank: 3
 - Invalid: 0

The budget proposal passes by majority vote.

7. OPEN FLOOR

The floor is opened for any remaining question.

Espen (Chair of Games Co) asks to see the video of the Polar Plunge promised after Frosty Fundraising

- Ivar connects his laptop and shows the video with a healthy bit of shame, because he screams quite loudly in the video.

No further questions are posted, so Boyan closes the Open Floor.
